#### Tabernacle=Tent of Meeting

Let them make for me a sanctuary, so that I may live among them.

Exodus 25:8



Two qualifications for the builders of the tabernacle:

Will

&

Skill



- Let everyone who has a *willing* heart... Ex 35:5
- Everyone whose heart stirred him to action and everyone whose spirit was willing...Ex 35:21
- They came, men and women alike, all who had willing hearts...
  Ex 35:22
- ...everyone whose *heart stirred* him to volunteer to do the work Ex 36:2



Each one of you should give just as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, because God loves a cheerful giver.

2 Cor 9:7



God invites.

He wants the willing.



Willing workers experience the work of God of in their lives.



Two qualifications for the builders of the tabernacle:

Will

&

Skill



- Every skilled person among you... Ex 35:10
- and all the women whose heart stirred them to action and who were skilled spun goats' hair. Ex 35:26
- Moses summoned Bezalel and Oholiab and every skilled person in whom the Lord had put skill...Ex 36:2
- So all the *skilled* people who were doing all the work on the sanctuary came from the work they were doing. Ex 36:4



WILL has to do with heart motivation; SKILL has to do with capacity and gifting.



Do not neglect the spiritual gift you have, given to you and confirmed by prophetic words when the elders laid hands on you. Take pains with these things; be absorbed in them, so that everyone will see your progress. Be conscientious about how you live and what you teach. Persevere in this, because by doing so you will save both yourself and those who listen to you.
